## Rewrite Tips

- **Intro:** The concise description of your business meeting sets the stage nicely for your personal statement. Combine the first two paragraphs of your original essay while cutting out the excess should suffice.
- **Body:** Here you should talk about your work experience. Highlight it with the your experience with your venture competition. You could mention the life lessons you have learned from work experience and how you will apply them to law school and to the real world.
- **Conclusion:** Conclude by summing up all that you have learned about yourself. You feel that you belong in law school because of your experience has pointed you in that direction. Explain how you are prepared to take the next step and apply everything you have learned to law school.
